Nanotech Camp Rules for Participants:

We hope that your experience at the Nanotech Camp is safe, fun, positive, and exciting. In order for this to happen for you and for all participants at the camp, the following Nanotech Camp Rules must be followed:

- Camp participant must follow all tenets of the Nanotech Camp Behavioral Expectations Code of Conduct that you and your parent or guardian agreed to during the camp registration process.
 - Please review this document again prior to camp arrival as a reminder of the Code of Conduct for this camp.
- Below are some of the very important Nanotech Camp Rules that we are highlighting and that you must follow:
 - Safety:
 - Always listen to your guides, instructors, and chaperones.
 - If you have any problems, tell your guide, instructor, or chaperone immediately.
 - Many of the tools and materials in use are very dangerous. Please stay with your group at all times and do not handle anything until invited to by one of the staff.
 - Courtesy in the Classroom and during Activities:
 - Please give the staff your full attention at all times:
 - Questions are always welcome and encouraged.
 - Personal conversations during activities are not.
 - Please turn off your cell phones during activities.
 - They can be turned on and used during breaks and lunch (with chaperone approval).
 - Courtesy during breaks:
 - The ESB Building and Engineering I Building are professional research facilities. While in and around the building we expect to see appropriate professionalism from all our visitors.
 - Courtesy during tours and evening hours:
 - The Nanotech Camp Rules (including the Nanotech Camp Behavioral Expectations Code of Conduct) apply during your entire stay at UCSB. This includes evening / night hours. Please remember to follow these rules at these times also.
- Any participant who is judged to be a substantial discipline problem and/or safety risk may be expelled from the camp by the Camp Leader or Outreach Coordinator.

We hope to make each Nanotech participants experience safe, fun, positive, and exciting. Your behavior and that of your peers will go a long way to making this a reality.
